

CAG2 installation guide for MacOS users

- Insert the CD into the disk drive; a CD symbol appears on your computer's desktop.
- Double-click on this symbol to open the CAG2 folder.
- Double-click on CAG.pgk in the CAG2 folder to start the installation. An assistant will guide you through the installation process.

- First, the program will check if your system meets the minimum requirements.
- If the requirements are met, you will be asked to accept the licence agreement.
- After accepting, you will be able to choose your installation path and directory.
- Click on the „Fortfahren“ (*Proceed*) button; a dialogue box opens.
- Click on the „Installieren“ (*Install*) button; the data will now be copied to your hard disk drive.

- After installation of the CAG files, the program will automatically check if the X11 system component is installed.
- If X11 is not found, a dialogue box will open and you will be asked to install it.
- To start the installation, click the „OK“ button.
- Note: It is necessary to see the X11 installation through to the end, even if the CAG2 installation routine shows the message „Installation abgeschlossen“ (*Installation complete*): The program will not be able to run without X11, even if the CAG2 data have been correctly copied to the hard disk drive.
- During installation, a „CAG2“ icon is automatically created on your desktop. Double-clicking on this icon will start the CAG2 program.

Special functions for Mac:

- To Cut/copy and paste (cf. user manual ch. 2.5.1.2) use the key combinations CTRL+X/CTRL+C and CTRL+V.
- To implement the right mouse button (for bookmarking etc.) press CTRL+mouse button.
- You get square brackets (cf. user manual ch. 2.4.3) by pressing Alt+5/Alt+6.
